Michael Keenan, Deputy Minister of Transport, Canada



Michael Keenan was appointed Deputy Minister of Transport on March 14, 2016. He has extensive experience in management and economic analysis and policy development in the Government of Canada.

Before Transport Canada, Michael served as the Associate Deputy Minister at Natural Resources since 2013.

Before that, at Environment Canada he was responsible for strategic policy development, economic analysis, coordination of federal/provincial relations, and the Federal Sustainable Development Strategy. He also served as the Vice-President of Organizational Leadership at the Canada School of Public Service and as the Director General of Economic Analysis at Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, where he also chaired the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Committee of Agriculture.

Earlier in his public service career, Michael worked in the federal Privy Council Office, at Finance Canada and at the British Columbia Ministry of Finance.

Michael holds a B.A. (Honours) from Saint Francis Xavier University and an M.A. in economics from Queen's University.
