

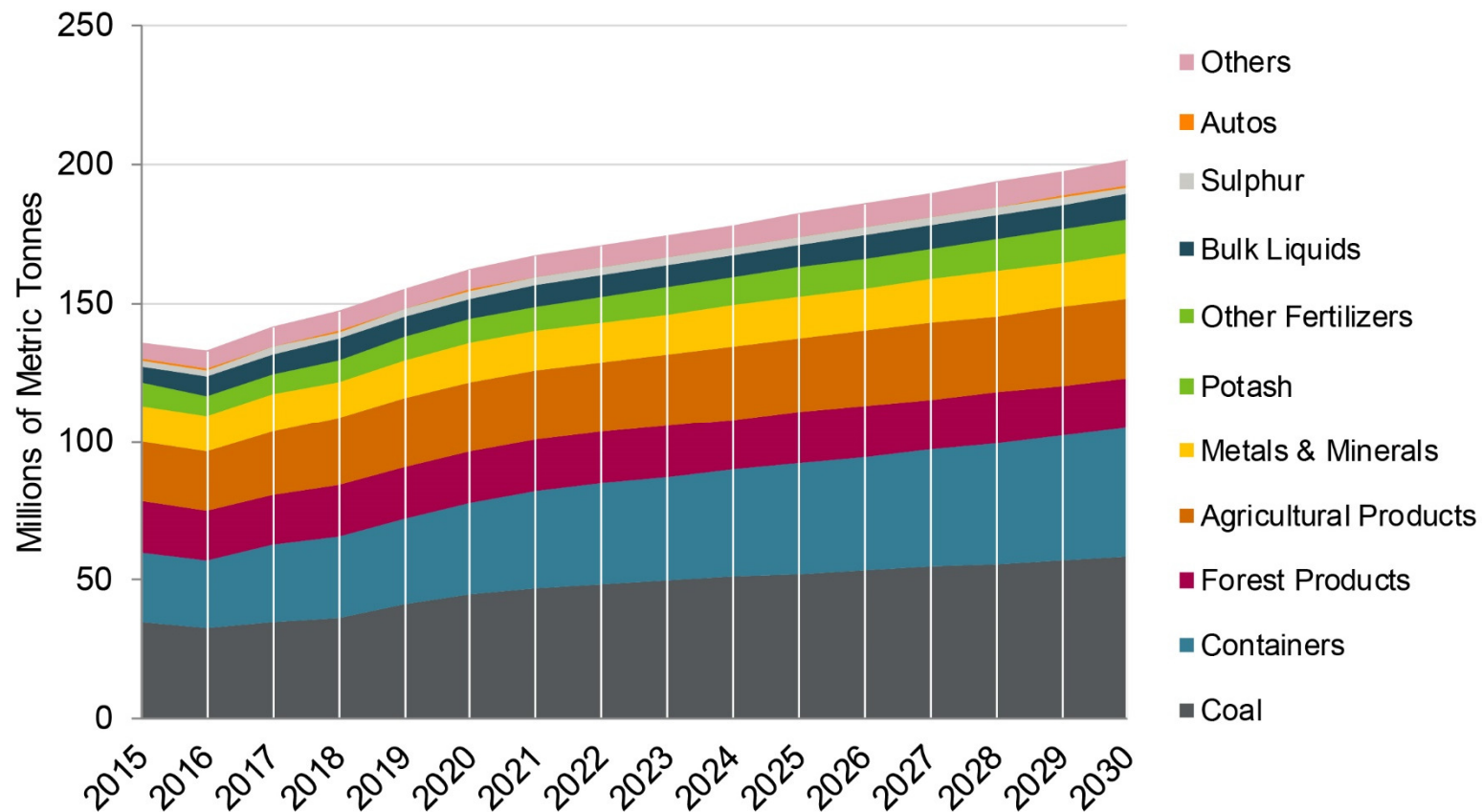

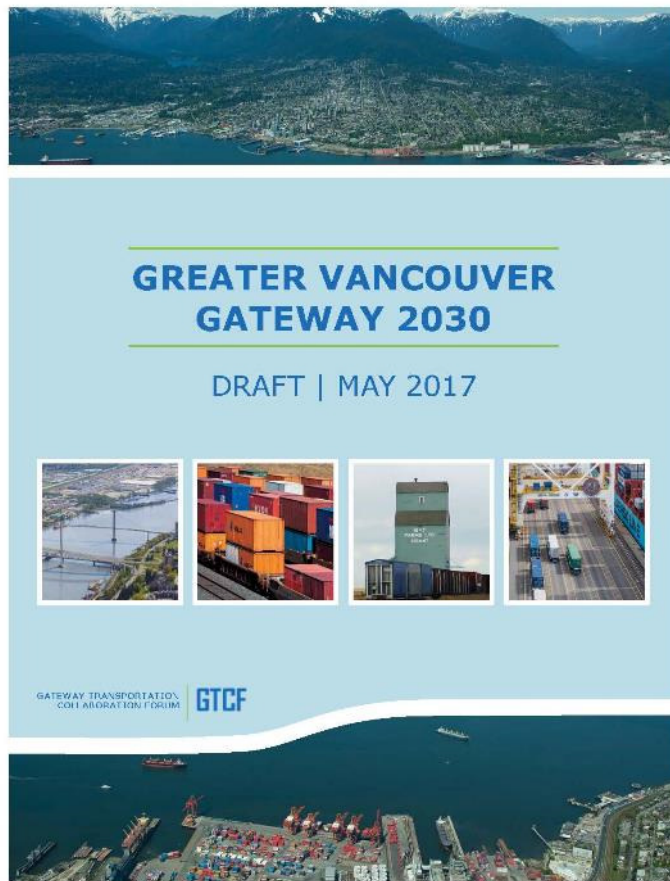

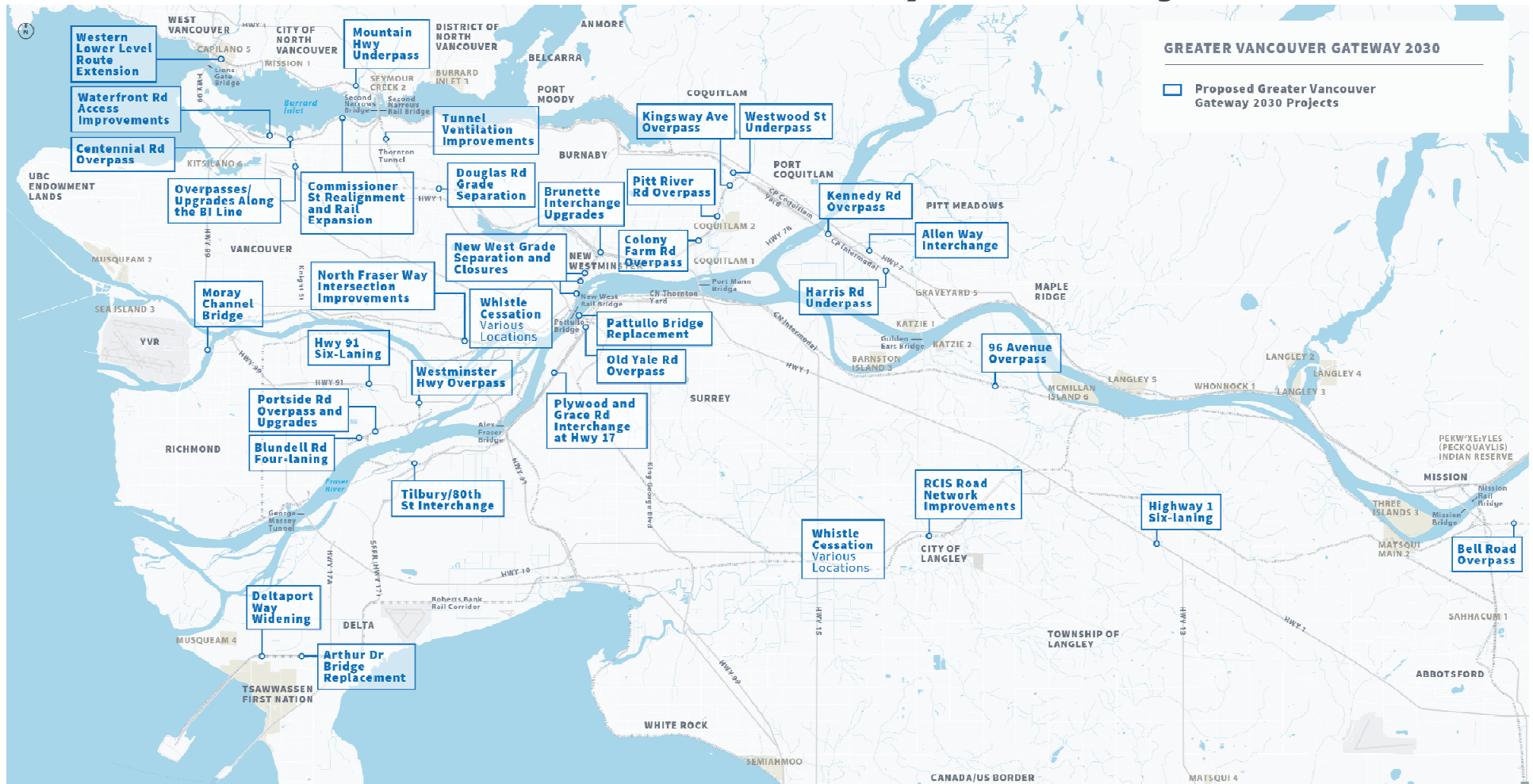
## Greater Vancouver Gateway 2030

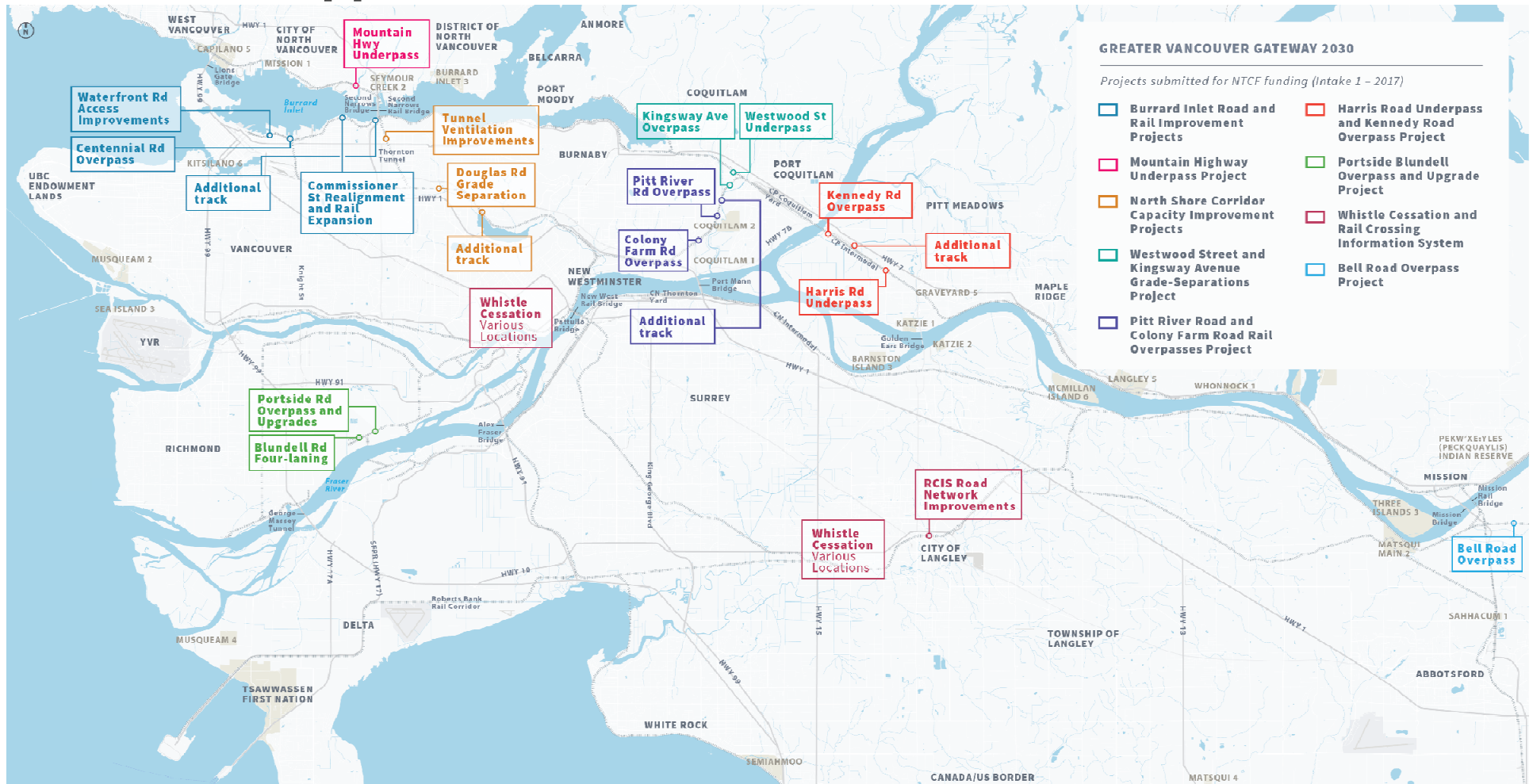

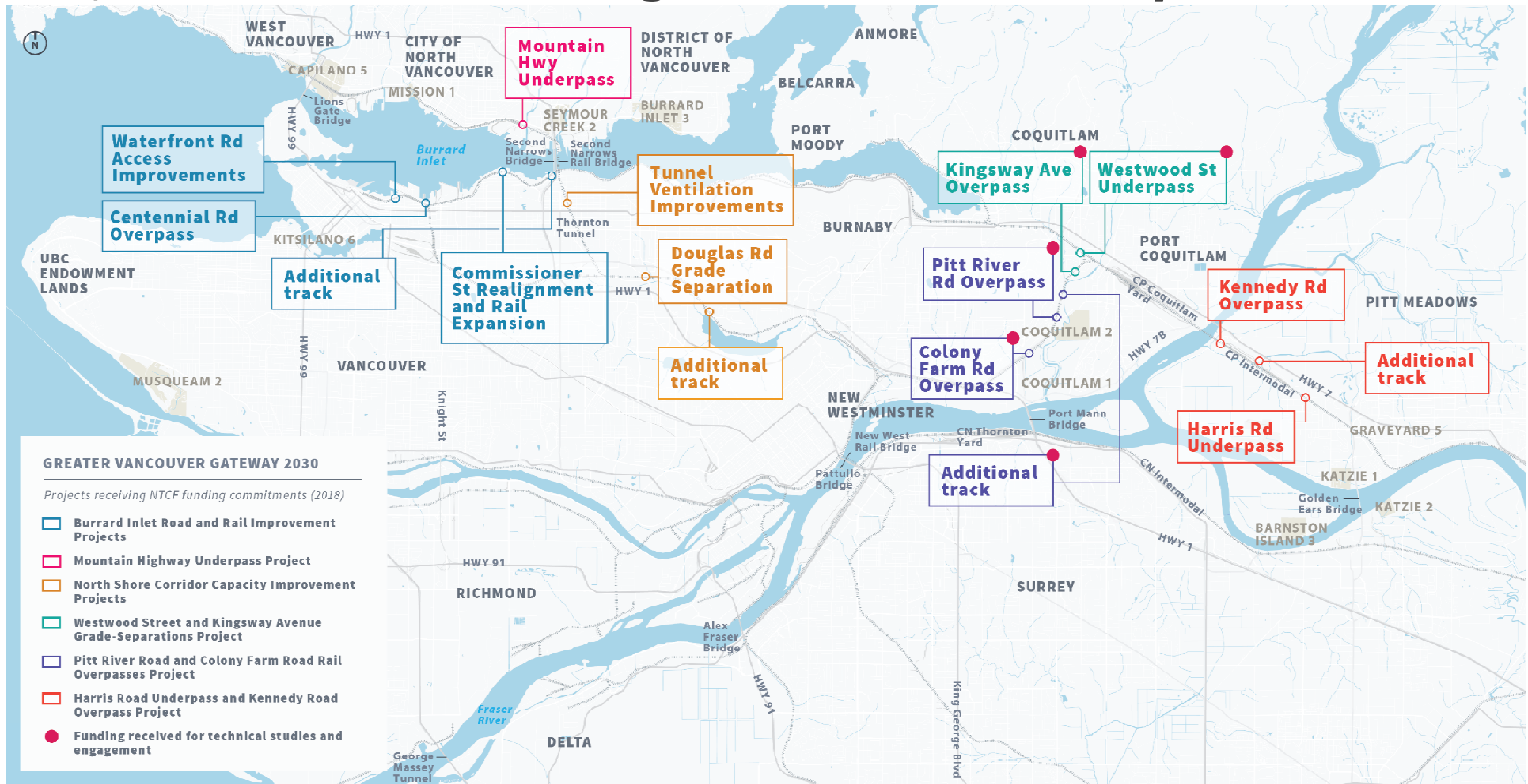
