


ICAO SMS MODEL

John F. Kennedy International Airport **opened in 1948** as New York International Airport but was commonly known as Idlewild Airport.

- The number of passengers by years 1961 – 10 million
- 2018 60 million
- 2024 63 million
- 2030 75 million projected
- » Directly employs 37,000 workers
- » Generates more than \$16 billion in wages and nearly 300,000 jo across the region
- » 4 runways
- » 4,930 acres

TRANSFORMING JFK INTO A MODERN 21ST CENTURY AIRPORT

John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) is one of the busiest airports in the nation and is an indispensable part of global travel and the region's economy. The airport handles nearly 62 million passengers a year, supports 280,000 jobs, and generates more than \$51 billion in sales and \$17.1 billion in wages. It is an essential component of the world's air transportation system and a regional economic driver.




